





Cultural activities carried out by the French Institute of Cambodia

Starting on September 12 at 6:30 pm, the exhibition "Insects: The Art of Detail" will be held at the French Institute. Admission is free, and it will run until November 1. The exhibition was produced by the Medical and Veterinary Entomology Unit of the Pasteur Institute of Cambodia, in partnership with the French Embassy. The exhibition "Insects: The Art of Detail" reveals this little-known, abundant, and beautiful biodiversity through a series of photographs.

Trained in unique photography techniques developed by French inventor Nathanaël Maury, the members of this unit can capture extremely small subjects, such as mosquito eggs, in very high resolution. These crystal-clear images reveal breathtaking details that are essential for identifying species and understanding their interactions with their environment. They also allow us to discover unexpected elements, opening up new perspectives in entomology, the study of insects.

Indeed, insects account for 85% of described animal species, but millions remain to be identified, particularly in Cambodia and Laos, where wildlife remains largely unstudied. Pollution, climate change, and overexploitation of resources threaten to destroy this natural heritage before it is even discovered.

Guided tour of the exhibition

Through a guided tour of the exhibition "Insects: The Art of Detail," presented from September 12 to November 1, 2025, visitors will discover art and science. This exhibition documents the sublime but fragile biodiversity of insects and raises awareness of the ecological risks associated with their disappearance.

3. Digital Activity CHUCHEL:


